NOTE: Sharing allowed in all events except club competitions. A list will be posted for each event sharing is allowed for those wanting to share. It will be a member's responsibility to pair up with another member who wants to share and to inform the drawmaster who that will be on or before the event.

A choice of the following may be made:

- A. One person plays two games and one person plays one game, choice is up to the two people sharing.**
- B. One person plays from the home end and the other person plays from the away end using the same set of bowls.**
- C. One player plays first two ends and the other player plays the next two ends, etc. Players get to walk up and down the rink for two ends at a time. If different bowls are used, they must have stickers so the skip can recognize them. Stickers are available in the file drawer next to the drawmaster's table.**

NEW: There will be no cancelled games in league play unless declared by the coordinator or his nominee at greenside. Cancelled games will not be rescheduled, simply play the next scheduled opponent.
